Wayne State Head Men's Basketball Coach**

Jeff Kaminsky moves into his second season as head men's basketball coach at Wayne State College. In his first year with the Wildcat program, Kaminsky doubled Wayne State's win total from the previous season (5-24 to 10-19). Under Kaminsky, the Wildcats won more road games in the 2016-17 season (six) than the previous three years combined (five).

Kaminsky has 30 years of head coaching experience at the college level and has recorded 462 career wins. Prior to arriving at Wayne State, Kaminsky spent 11 years as head coach at Valley City State in North Dakota where he was 183-144 that included five 20-win seasons and two trips to the NAIA National Tournament in his last four years at VCSU.

Other coaching stops for Kaminsky include 11 years (1994-2005) at Wisconsin-Superior and seven seasons as head coach at Mid-State Technical College in Wisconsin.

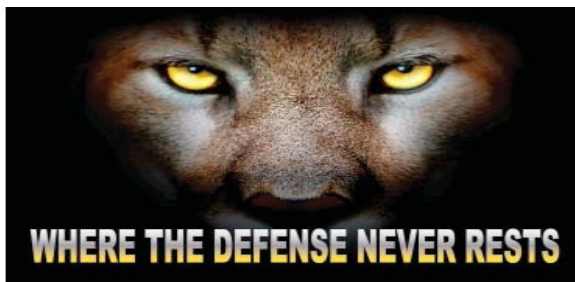


WSC Assistant Coach Nathan Stover

Nathan Stover is in his second season as assistant coach at Wayne State College. Prior to WSC, Stover served 11 years as assistant coach at Valley City State in North Dakota where he also worked as intramural director. He helped turnaround a Viking basketball program by recording five 20-win seasons in nine years that included a pair of trips to the NAIA National Tournament.

Stover also spent four years in the high school coaching ranks in North Dakota where he was head boys basketball coach at Jamestown High School for three years and one as head girls and boys basketball coach at Harvey High School.

Stover got his start in collegiate coaching as a student assistant at North Dakota State working under Tom Billeter and Ray Giacoletti. He later moved up to graduate assistant coach at NDSU and worked under former WSC head coach Greg McDermott and current Northern Iowa head coach Ben Jacobson.
